•To increase the number of students achieving Above the NZ curricula level in knowledge, skills and capabilities to 35% by the end of 2019. This is a shift of 157 students,



Centrally Funded PLD Dr Alison Davis

- 75 Hours (approx. 9 days PLD) professional development in writing with Dr Alison Davis
- Focus on Mentoring and coaching within and across leaders= 3 days
- Reviewing teaching as inquiry to focus on student agency conditions of effective writing instruction that develop agency, motivation and engagement for all teachers across the schools ..whole staff meetings =3 days
- Supporting teachers to identify their priority students and their next steps. Knowing the learner and how they learn..
- Year group workshops exploring writing across the disciplines, Coaching and mentoring of within and across school leaders. 1-1 and year group support based on within and across leaders teaching as inquiry= 3 all day sessions
